

Job Description: Physical Education Teacher

Purpose Statement:

The Physical Education Teacher position is a unique position at Anser. This position fulfills the physical education program with our kindergarteners through 8th graders. Physical Education is experienced in multiple areas at Anser. Currently, this position is a .56FTE position (part-time 22 hours per week) and will expand to a full-time position in \$Y2022. PE is taught in the weekly specials classes and through Anser's Community Based Curriculum (CBC)/Electives programs. This position is part of a team that collaboratively plans curriculum within the core practices set by the EL Education model.

Essential Functions:

- Individuals applying for this position must believe in high accountability and collaboration
- Be comfortable with both individual as well as group decision-making
- Knowledgeable in children's developmental milestones with the ability to instill life-long physical activity and character growth while developing a cooperative crew.
- In physical education instruction, the individual will:
 - provide abundant opportunities to understand physical health
 - provide rich health experiences
 - promote life long physical activity
 - Understand that physical education focuses on the development of fitness and motor skills, as well as enhancing mental, social, and emotional abilities through cooperative and team-building activities.
- This position is responsible for teaching physical education and health state standards.
- This position collaborates with the CBC/Electives Team to develop and implement the physical education dimension of these programs.
- This position is responsible for finding coaches or coaching Anser sponsored sports teams i.e. JH Cross Country, 5th-6th Girls and Boys Basketball, Girls on the Run.
- Candidates need to be aware there are expectations that exist outside of the regular school day and hours (Staff Meetings, Professional Development, Back to School Picnic, Back to School Night, Family Information Nights, etc.).

Qualifications:

- Candidates must hold, or be eligible for, an Idaho K-8 Teaching Certificate and/or meet all Idaho State Department of Education standards for a Highly Qualified Teacher.
- It is desirable that candidates possess deep knowledge and understanding of the Idaho Standards for physical and health education.

Important Info:

• Anser Charter School in the beginning stages of expansion. We will be expanding our enrollment in SY2021 and the following three years. In SY 2021, the PE position will be a .75FTE (30 hours) and SY2022 will be a full-time position 1.0FTE (40 hours).

- 6. Have the desire to work in a non-traditional, school environment.
- 7. Can develop curriculum that is engaging, rigorous and aligns with Common Core State Standards and school expectations.
- 8. Are passionate about what Anser has to offer staff, students, and families.

Anser is named after the Latin word for goose and seeks to embody the supportive and collaborative characteristics of its namesake. The school serves approximately 365 students K-8. We are located in Garden City and within the boundaries of the Boise School District.
